

JAlbum install steps

- 1 Install the software
2. Now that the software is installed CLOSE it if it is open.

Now click on the file SBCC2.JASkip which will load into jalbum the skin currently used in the SBCC Web Site.

Basicly it is the Turtle Skin StoneWall with some changes to make thigs consistent in the web site and I called it SBCC2 .

Now Start jalbum and you should see in the skin style (lower left) SBCC2 if not move cursor to find it , Make sure Stonewall is also selected.

- 3 Now Select SETTINGS
 - Select tab pages set make slide pages
 - Select tab SBCC2 tab
 - Sub tab Images set fit image to browser
 - Set shrink only
 - Set after last image ASK
 - Set thumbnails by default
 - unset selling photo
 - Unset printing
 - Sub Tab Social unset facebook, email etc
- Apply settings

- 3 Save it as default in the File Tab.

Now one can start importing pictures into Projects as they are set up on the sbcc web.

The rest will require to read the help file

There is an ability to upload the final results directly to the web site Album folder
One needs the FTP id and password or else move it to Web Expressions and publish it that way. JAlbum saves items into your document folder called My Albums

To use the builtin ftp go to right side of UPLOAD (lower left of screen you will find a down arrow for the ftp manager

server ftp.sbccsail.com ftp id ftpsail@sbccsail.com password jp7R3p1Hz4
set ftp protocol to FTP4 .

Please note when you upload directly to server make sure you are in the correct directory of the Albums and that there is a folder there to upload to.

Folders used by program

Image Directory c: program files /Jalbum

Skin directory c:/Yourid/appdata/roaming/Jalbum/skins/sbcc2

Config directory c:/your id/appdata/roaming/jalbum

When creating an album

- 1 select new project
- 2 Select add files in right screen and find your folder of pictures
- 3 Select which picture you want to be the heading (has a heart next to it)
- 4 Using winscp ftp program create the folder in the server first
- 5 Select create album
- 6 Select upload Make sure you select the newly created folder in the server
- 7 Run it
